JACOB GREENBERG APPOINTED TO FILL BLAINE COUNTY COMMISSION VACANCY

(BOISE) – Governor C.L. "Butch" Otter announced his appointment today of Hailey businessman **Jacob Greenberg** to a vacancy on the Blaine County Commission left by the recent resignation of Commissioner Tom Bowman.

Greenberg, 59, an accountant and financial analyst and manager, was among three nominees for the position submitted to Governor Otter by the Blaine County Democratic Central Committee. He will complete the final two years of Bowman's term representing central Blaine County.

He currently is the owner and operator of Shorty's Diner in Hailey. He has a bachelor's degree in business administration from California State University-Northridge and attended Pepperdine University. Greenberg has been involved in a number of professional and civic organizations since moving to Idaho 30 years ago. Greenberg and his wife Jeanne have two adult sons.

"I'm honored and humbled by this appointment to the Board of Blaine County Commissioners. Thanks to Governor Otter and his staff for the exemplary work they did in vetting all the candidates, and thanks to all of those who supported me throughout the process.
