ROCKLAND WILL HOST GOVERNOR OTTER'S NEXT CAPITAL FOR A DAY

(BOISE) – Governor C.L. "Butch" Otter announced today that the Power County community of **Rockland** will host the next Capital for a Day on **Wednesday, January 27th**.

Governor Otter brings State government to Idahoans living outside Boise each month by making a different town in Idaho the state's "Capital for a Day." The meetings provide local residents an opportunity to have open discussions about government issues and public policy with Governor Otter, members of his Cabinet and other senior State officials.

The Capital for a Day on January 27th is scheduled from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Rockland City Hall**. The Governor also will attend a luncheon with local leaders and residents at the same location.

State officials joining Governor Otter at Capital for a Day will include **Lieutenant Governor Brad Little; Dustin Miller, administrator of the Office of Species Conservation; John Chatburn, administrator of the Office of Energy Resources; Brian Oakey, deputy director of the Idaho State Department of Agriculture; Debbie Critchfield, a member of the State Board of Education; Ed Schriever, deputy director of the Department of Fish and Game; and Pete Black, a member of the Idaho Parks and Recreation Board**. Also on hand will be representatives from the Department of Commerce, Idaho Transportation Department, and Idaho Division of Building Safety.

"While the Legislature is meeting in Boise, my Cabinet and I are pleased to be able to travel to communities like Rockland and meet with the citizens whose lives can be impacted by what we do at the Capitol. It's a great way to help us identify the issues that matter to the people we serve," Governor Otter said. "We look forward to hearing directly from the people of Rockland and Power County about what they need to make their community an even better place to live, work and raise a family."
