WHEREAS, organic farms in Idaho are increasing in size and popularity, with 254 organic farms currently operating throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, organic agriculture contributes over \$71.2 million annually to Idaho's economy; and

WHEREAS, organic agriculture stimulates the local economy by supporting local businesses and reinvesting money back into the community; and

WHEREAS, consumer trends show great interest in eating organically and supporting local producers; and

WHEREAS, Idaho farmers cultivate a wide variety of quality organic products including fruits, vegetables, meats, dairy and wine as well as non-food products such as flowers and hay; and

WHEREAS, Idaho ranks in the top 10 in the nation for the production of many organic products; and

WHEREAS, consumers can find Idaho organic products at their local farmers market, as well as some grocery stores and restaurants; and

WHEREAS, the state of Idaho, supports the development and operation of organic agriculture;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Governor C.L. "Butch" Otter, Governor of the State Idaho, do hereby proclaim June 18-24, 2011 as

Idaho Organic Week

in Idaho.
