WHEREAS, Ed Stimpson also was U.S. Ambassador representing the United States on the Council of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), led the General Aviation Agency’s Office of Congressional Affairs (GAMA), helped create the “Be a Pilot” program, and was the Chairman of the Flight Safety Foundation; and
