*WHEREAS, it is recognized that learning outdoor skills related to the heritage of hunting, fishing and conservation enhances the education of children and develops in them the ethics of good sportsmanship; and*

*WHEREAS, all children in Idaho deserve the opportunity to learn the legacies of hunting, fishing and wildlife conservation; and*

*WHEREAS, the children of all military families whose parents are serving on active duty to defend the constitutions of the United States and of the State of Idaho deserve the opportunity to learn outdoor skills that will enhance their lives; and*

*WHEREAS, the Snake River Chapter of the Wild Turkey Federation, the Treasure Valley Chapter of Safari Club International, the Idaho National Guard, the Idaho Department of Fish and Game, the Nampa Bow Chiefs, and Howard’s Tackle Shop of Nampa have donated volunteers and resources to create a Kids’ Conservation and Military Appreciation Day; and*
