WHEREAS, the Idaho Montana Chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects actively encourages creating or improving access to places for physical activity within our communities, including parks, recreational facilities, bicycle paths, walking trails and sidewalks, as well as sustainable design; and

WHEREAS, landscape architects will join across the country during the month of April to educate the public about how their profession promotes career choices in landscape architecture; and

WHEREAS, the theme of Career Discovery with a focus on underrepresented minorities for National Landscape Architecture Month (NLAM) 2014 will spur a nationwide movement, teaching children, young adults, and even teachers just how artfully landscape architects design their world, and that from community parks to residential design, there's a field out there for any ambitious student; and

WHEREAS, working with landscape architects, communities can promote health and well-being by encouraging the development of environments that offer rich social, economic and environmental benefits such as healthy, livable communities;
