WHEREAS, Sam battled diabetes from a very early age with dignity and humility and never let this disease hold him back from any activity; and

WHEREAS, Sam was a friend to every person he ever encountered and truly loved and lived life to the fullest; and

WHEREAS, Sam's fight with this disease finally ended with his untimely death in a car accident on April 12, 2006; and
