WHEREAS, we can help protect Idaho's air by driving less, using alternative transportation, limiting idling, avoiding burning and complying with local burning ordinances, and conserving energy; and

WHEREAS, we can help protect our personal health by keeping up-to-date on daily Air Quality Index reports, avoiding prolonged exposure, modifying outdoor exercise routines on air quality alert days, and seeking medical care on air quality alert days if symptoms warrant; and

WHEREAS, we can enjoy the health benefits of outdoor activity and breathing clean air; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to set aside a special time to call upon all Idahoans to increase their knowledge of air quality and how they can help protect Idaho's air and their health;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the State of Idaho, do hereby proclaim April 28th - May 2nd, 2014 to be

AIR QUALITY AWARENESS WEEK

in Idaho, and encourage all Idahoans, young and old, to recognize the value and importance of healthy air and make every effort to learn about and incorporate actions into their daily pursuits to protect Idaho's air.
