WHEREAS, The Pacific Northwest Chapter of the Myasthenia Gravis Foundation of America, Inc. (MGFA) was founded by Marian Forschler, RN, BSN in 1984; and

WHEREAS, myasthenia gravis (MG) is a rare, often misdiagnosed autoimmune, neuromuscular disease that causes weakness of the voluntary muscles; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately 70,000 people living with MG in the United States today, including 80 known cases in Idaho; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Northwest Chapter provides information, support, and referrals to people in Idaho with myasthenia gravis and their families; education to the general public and the medical community, and supports research towards improved treatment options and the eventual cure of the disease; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Northwest Chapter will celebrate Myasthenia Gravis Awareness Month on June 18th;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the State of Idaho, do hereby proclaim June 18th, 2014 to be
