WHEREAS, community health centers in Idaho have provided effective, efficient community-directed health care in Idaho for 40 years; and

WHEREAS, community health centers throughout Idaho work together as members of the Idaho Primary Care Association and have been part of this collaboration since 1983; and

WHEREAS, Idaho community health centers form an integral piece of Idaho's overall health care system through 13 centers located in 43 communities across Idaho providing medical, dental and behavioral health services to over 153,000 Idahoans; and

WHEREAS, Idaho community health centers provide access to care for all Idahoans of any income level; and

WHEREAS, Idaho community health centers are community-directed medical safety net providers operating as the medical home for Idaho families, providing timely preventive and primary care services through early diagnosis and treatment for illnesses; and

WHEREAS, Idaho community health centers save taxpayer dollars, advocating patient responsibility by requiring all patients to participate in their cost of care; and

WHEREAS, the State of Idaho has invested in community health centers to help them enhance their service delivery infrastructure better meet the medical needs of their surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, Idaho community health centers serve as a key partner in the success of Your Health Idaho by assisting Idahoans in making well-informed choices about health coverage for their families; and

WHEREAS, the State of Idaho recognizes and values the contributions and cost-effectiveness of community health centers in providing access to primary health care, improving the lives of citizens of the great State of Idaho;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the State of Idaho, do hereby proclaim the week of August 10<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>, 2014 to be
