WHEREAS, "An Act to establish the Judicial Court of the United States," approved September 24, 1789, directed the appointment of United States Marshals and launched the United States Marshals Service; and

WHEREAS, the United States Marshals Service is a federal law enforcement agency within the United States Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, during 225 years of service, United States Marshals have executed warrants, distributed presidential proclamations, helped conduct the national census, protected the President and the federal courts, provided for the custody and transportation of federal prisoners, maintained and disposed of seized and forfeited properties, ensured the safe conduct of judicial proceedings, protected federal judges and jurors and other members of the federal judiciary, provided for the security of witnesses and directed and coordinated fugitive task forces to apprehend dangerous fugitives; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Marshals Service is the nation's oldest and most versatile federal law enforcement agency; and

WHEREAS, the men and women of the United States Marshals Service have served the nation and this State valiantly with dedication to justice, integrity, and service;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the state of Idaho, do hereby proclaim September 24, 2014 to be

U.S. MARSHALS DAY

in Idaho.
