WHEREAS, effective education – including science, technology, engineering and math – can help foster bright young talent for the future workforce and healthy economic growth for our state; and

WHEREAS, resources are tight and teachers often spend hundreds of dollars from their own pockets each year to provide needed materials and supplies for students; and

WHEREAS, businesses and corporations – the employers of the next generation now in public schools – can invest in their future workforce by making it easy for communities to come together and help one another while supporting their own social responsibilities; and
