**Proclamation**

State Capitol

WHEREAS, there is risk to life and property as a result of declared and ongoing disaster emergencies in the State of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, there is peril to public safety and property which is likely to be beyond the control of local governments; and

WHEREAS, disaster emergency proclamations remain in effect for 30 days unless otherwise extended by 30-day increments or terminated;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the State of Idaho, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 46-1008 of the Idaho Code, do hereby find and therefore proclaim and declare:

1. The following disaster emergencies are hereby extended for a period of 30 days unless extended or sooner terminated within this period.
  - i. ID-01-2010
    - Flooding due to heavy rain, river and stream runoff and above average spring precipitation is occurring in Idaho, Adams, Valley, Payette, Lewis, Gem, and Washington counties, Idaho.
  - ii. ID-01-2013
    - Very dry fuels, lightning, high winds and smoke have created perilous situations and damage to public property constitutes a significant threat to life, property and the environment within the impacted wildfire areas.

(a) The nature of the preceding emergencies is the occurrence and imminent threat to public safety.

(b) The areas threatened by the preceding disasters have been individually included under this proclamation.

2. This Proclamation serves, pursuant to Section 46-1008, Idaho Code, as authorization for the resources of state government to assist efforts to deal with the preceding disaster emergencies.
