WHEREAS, the Idaho Rodeo Hall of Fame mentors their youth through the offering of 4 youth awards in the areas of Agriculture, Scholastic Achievement, Community Service and Rodeo; and

WHEREAS, rodeo was not originally a sporting event, but an integral part of cattle ranching, and today there are still many “ranch rodeos” which continue to be a rich part of the State of Idaho’s history;
