WHEREAS, beginning on August 12, 2015 there is an imminent threat to life and property as a result of Wild Fires, within the State of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, drought conditions, very dry fuels, and high winds have created this perilous situation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the State of Idaho, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 46-1008 of the Idaho Code do hereby find and therefore proclaim and declare:

1. That a state of disaster emergency described in Section 46-1008, Idaho Code exists in the State of Idaho.
2. The nature of the emergency is the occurrence and imminent threat to public safety and property arising from the numerous wildfires in Lewis and Idaho Counties, and amended to include Clearwater, Owyhee Counties, and hereby amended to include The Nez Perce Tribe.
3. The state of disaster emergency proclaimed and declared on August 13, 2015, and amended on August 14, 2015 to include Owyhee County and amend on August 16, 2015 to include Clearwater County, and amended to include the Nez Perce Tribe on August 19, 2015, and shall exist for a period of thirty days unless terminated, modified or unless extended for thirty-day increments.
4. This Proclamation, No. ID-02-2015, 2015 Idaho Wildfires serves pursuant to section 46-1008, Idaho Code, as authorization for the resources of state government to assist in efforts to deal with the disaster emergency of the 2015 Lewis, Clearwater, Owyhee and Idaho Counties and The Nez Perce Tribe, Wildfires.
5. That the state of disaster emergency proclamation, No. ID-02-2015, 2015 Idaho Wildfires, shall include the impacted areas within Lewis, Clearwater, Owyhee, and Idaho Counties and The Nez Perce Tribe, of the State of Idaho.
