Proclamation

WHEREAS, there is risk to life and property as a result of declared and ongoing disaster emergencies through the State of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, there is peril to public safety and property which is likely to be beyond the control of local governments; and

WHEREAS, disaster emergency proclamations remain in effect for 30 days unless otherwise extended by 30 day increments or terminated;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "BUTCH" OTTER, Governor of the State of Idaho, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 46-1008 of the Idaho Code do hereby find and therefore proclaim and declare:

1. The following disaster emergencies are hereby extended for a period of 30 days unless extended or sooner terminated within this period:

- i. ID-01-2015
 - Drought conditions, very dry fuels, and high winds have created perilous situations arising from the 2015 Cape Horn Fire in Bonner County and Kootenai County, Idaho; and
- ii. ID-02-2015
 - Drought conditions, very dry fuels, and high winds have created perilous situations arising from the wildfires within Lewis, Idaho, and Owyhee counties, Idaho; and
- iii. ID-03-2015
 - Windstorm has damaged critical electrical, telecommunications infrastructure, blocked transportation routes and forced citizens into temporary shelters due to very cold and wet winter conditions with continued high winds that have created a perilous situation for Benewah, Boundary, Bonner and Kootenai counties, Idaho; and
- iv. ID-04-2015
 - Heavy snow loads and freezing conditions have damaged critical electrical infrastructure with continued, very cold and wet winter conditions, which have crated this perilous situation; and
- v. ID-01-2016
 - Massive landslide occurred on February 18, 2016 in Idaho County closing State Highway 14 and isolating the communities of Elk City, Dixie and others.
- vi. ID-02-2016
 - Drought conditions, very dry fuels and high winds have created perilous situations arising from the wildfire in Bonneville County, Idaho.

(a) The nature of the preceding emergencies is the occurrence and imminent threat to public safety.

(b) The areas threatened by the preceding disasters have been individually included under this proclamation.

2. This Proclamation serves, pursuant to Section 46-1008, Idaho Code, as authorization for the resources of state government to assist efforts to deal with the preceding disaster emergencies.
