WHEREAS, credit unions are not-for-profit financial cooperatives, democratically owned and operated and founded by people working together toward their mutual economic advancement; and

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of September 1936, in the city of Twin Falls, representatives of Idaho's first credit unions formed the Idaho Credit Union League as their trade association and for their mutual support; and

WHEREAS, the Idaho Credit Union League has for the past 75 years provided Idaho credit unions with effective advocacy, education and training, compliance information, and cost-effective products and services through cooperative business relationships with local business and the Credit Union National Association; and

WHEREAS, the Idaho Credit Union League and its affiliated credit unions embrace a "people-helping-people" philosophy through the pooling of personal resources and leadership abilities for the good of the cooperative, empowering members to improve their financial futures, and uniting to help those in need; and

WHEREAS, the Idaho Credit Union League has demonstrated outstanding leadership throughout the Idaho credit union community, the national credit union community, and the international credit union community since its formation 75 years ago; and

WHEREAS, on this 75th Anniversary of the Idaho Credit Union League it appropriate to recognize the service this organization has provided to Idaho credit unions and through them the citizens of the great State of Idaho.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C.L. "Butch" Otter, Governor of the State of Idaho, do hereby proclaim September 12, 2011 as

Idaho Credit Union League Day

in Idaho.
