### **GOVERNOR OTTER SCHEDULES JUNE CAPITAL FOR A DAY IN RIGBY**

(BOISE) – Governor C.L. "Butch" Otter announced today that his next Capital for a Day will be Wednesday, June 25th, in the Jefferson County seat of Rigby.

Governor Otter brings State government to Idahoans living outside Boise each month by making a different town in Idaho the state's "Capital for a Day." The meetings provide local residents an opportunity to have open discussions about government issues and public policy with Governor Otter, members of his Cabinet and other senior State officials.

The Capital for a Day on June 25th is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Rigby Senior Center. Governor Otter also will join local officials and residents at noon for a no-host lunch at the same location.

State officials joining Governor Otter at Capital for a Day will include Idaho Department of Fish and Game Director Virgil Moore, Department of Lands Director Tom Schultz, Department of Water Resources Director Gary Spackman, Department of Parks and Recreation Director Nancy Merrill, Department of Correction Director Brent Reinke, Division of Building Safety Administrator Kelly Pearce, Office of Energy Resources Administrator John Chatburn, Idaho State Tax Commissioner Tom Katsilometes, and Idaho Transportation Board member Lee Gagner. Also on hand to answer questions will be representatives from the Idaho Transportation Department, Department of Health and Welfare, Department of Environmental Quality and Department of Commerce.

"Rigby is in the very heart of the Upper Valley – a rich agricultural area that exemplifies the best of Idaho's rural values and traditions," Governor Otter said. "There is a culture here in Jefferson County that celebrates hard work, innovation and honest success. I have always felt at home here, and I'm excited about returning with my Cabinet members for Capital for a Day."
