WHEREAS, the great seal of the State of Idaho contains the image of a miner, symbolizing mining's significant role in our state's past, present and future; and

WHEREAS, the State of Idaho recognizes the contributions of Captain Joseph Raphael DeLamar, who founded the DeLamar Mining Company and established the historic town of DeLamar, Idaho, in 1888; and

WHEREAS, the DeLamar Project, bordering the historic Idaho community of Silver City, holds world-class deposits of gold and silver that have produced a notable supply of these minerals, contributing to the advancement of our nation's economic landscape, technological evolution, and our modern society; and

WHEREAS, Integra Resources has played a noteworthy role in working to revitalize the DeLamar Project, with a clear message to all stakeholders of its dedication to modern mining practices, including the promotion of responsible mineral extraction, environmental protection, land restoration; and

WHEREAS, Integra Resources is committed to modern mining practices, providing hundreds of direct and indirect jobs throughout Owyhee County, Idaho, and beyond; and

WHEREAS, Integra Resources aims to employ Idaho men and women who want to work near or around their hometowns and encourage those who have left to return by providing careers that allow employees to live, work, and raise a family in Idaho; and

WHEREAS, cultural significance and lifestyles will be at the forefront of all assessments made by Integra Resources, ensuring the reopening of the mine is constructed and planned in partnership with the people who live in the area and who have been good stewards of the land for generations; and
